

InstrumentalMusic Program



Students have the opportunity to learn an instrument during College hours from our highly trained and experienced music tutors. Our specialist staff can be matched to meet student's needs and develop their musicianship, whether they are a beginner or more experienced.

What The Program Involves

Classes are held on a rotating time schedule so that students can participate in Kennedy's Instrumental Program and not regularly miss any one particular lesson.

Instruments on offer in our 2024 Music Tuition program are as follows:

All students enrolled in the Instrumental Music Program are expected to be involved in an ensemble as soon as they reach the appropriate level of performance, and as opportunity allows. Students are allocated to an appropriate ensemble that rehearse either before school, during lunch or after school.

The College sponsors the Ensemble Program and there are no fees attached to these ensembles. Students are required to purchase their own instruments, and can seek advice from instrumental tutors where relevant.



Music Lesson Information

Tuition occurs once a week with each student receiving a 30 minute lesson with a qualified instrumental teacher. There is an average of nine lessons per term.

Timetables are distributed to all instrumental music students at the start of each term. These timetables are also entered weekly on SEQTA, which is a prompt to both students and teachers of the exact time and location of lessons.

The College provides performance opportunities for students in both the Instrumental and Ensemble Program through concerts, assemblies and other formal events, some of which are compulsory.

Terms & Conditions

Private individual lesson: 30 minutes at \$38.50 per lesson.

Shared group lesson: 30 minutes at \$25 per lesson, maximum number for group lessons is two students. An individual shorter lesson will take place if only one student attends.

ATAR Music Student: a reccomended length of 45 minutes at \$64 per lesson.

Payment is required before the commencement of lessons each term. If payment is not received by the tutor within two (2) weeks of the invoice due date, students will be refused lessons until payment is paid.

To discontinue lessons, parents must request the withdrawal of their child by Week 8 of the previous term, otherwise the full tuition fee for the following term must be paid.

No lessons will be given in the final week of each term to allow for catch up lessons - so in a typical term, there will be 8 or 9 Instrumental Music lessons given.



For lessons to commence, please be advised of the following enrolment timeline:

Lessons commencing beginning of the year: Enrolments close in late January each year.

Lessons commencing in Term 2, 3 or 4:

Enrol by Week 8 of the previous term.

Enrolled students will receive communication from their instrumental tutors and/or the Instrumental Music Coordinator prior to the commencement of instrumental music lessons at the College.
